VOLUNTEER NOTICE!! NEW & RENEWING volunteers **MUST** log on to ncsrisk.org/adventist as a first-time registrant and get started with the clearance process. Choose North America Division / Pacific Union / Northern CA Conf / Paradise Adventist Academy. .

If you still are not marked as cleared, go back to the training module and go to the very end. You have NOT reached the end if you do not bring up a screen that has the "submit for background check" button!!! Case sensitive; better to use Firefox or Google NOT Internet Explorer. **Your status is good for 3 years! Notices are sent to those who need to renew!**

BLOOD BORNE PATHOGENS COURSE: If you were assigned to take the Blood Bourne Pathogens course, this is why: You chose a teacher aide or other teacher category. "The Blood-Bourne Pathogens module is automatically assigned for Teacher related roles. Some candidates may request for this module but they are not required to do so. We may also un-assign this module if they wish to do so."

Please be aware that this web site is VERY case sensitive! Please remember to use capital letters consistently where appropriate. IE: If you did john doe, then you must consistently put your name in without caps. If you did John Doe, than you must consistently put your name in with caps. You will be locked out if you did not!
