If you still are not marked as cleared, go back to the training module and go to the very end. You have NOT reached the end if you do not bring up a screen that has the “submit for background check”

button!!! Case sensitive; better to use Firefox or Google NOT Internet Explorer. **Your status is good for 3 years!**
