## **Off-Campus Privileges During School Hours**

Students in grades 11 and 12 may go off campus during school hours on Mondays and Wednesdays provided that the following criteria are met:

- 1. Students may only go off campus during their lunch period. (Students who are on track for the College Prep Diploma may go off campus during their study hall period that is adjacent to their lunch period.)
- 2. Students may only go off campus if their Application for Permission to Drive off Campus is on file at the school. This application must be renewed annually.
- 3. Before students go off campus, they must check in with the designated school administrator and follow established sign-out procedures.
- 4. Students are not to congregate in the parking area or spend time in the vehicles parked there during the school day.
- 5. Students must not drive at a speed higher than 10 mph while on campus, and they must drive in a safe and prudent manner.
- 6. Students may not transport other students in their vehicles while they have a provisional driver's license.
- 7. Students who have a graduated driver's license may not transport student passengers in their vehicles unless their parents and the parents of the passengers have granted written permission.
- 8. Students may not ride with student drivers unless their parents and the parents of the student drivers have granted written permission.
- 9 Students must maintain an attendance grade of "A".
- 10. Students must have a grade of "B" or higher in all their classes on their current progress report, and they must have a GPA of 3.0 during the previous quarter.

Violations of any of the rules above may result in suspension of driving privileges.
